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A MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Friend,

We need your help! More than any other time since our opening, we are facing our greatest financial need to ensure men, women, and children in our community are able to access life-saving health services.

They could be your friends, neighbors or even family members. We all know of somebody, perhaps even yourself, who has fallen through programs, services, or insurances at some point in life, or simply cannot access the care needed. In fact, there are currently an estimated **22,000** low-income residents of all ages in the Carroll County community lacking adequate access to medical, dental and behavioral health care. Since 2005, Access Carroll is the only full time safety-net health care provider with a mission to serve at-risk residents in Carroll County. Access Carroll works closely as a partner with Carroll Hospital and Carroll County Health Department to ensure those most in need are receiving timely, high quality, and critically needed health services.

Access Carroll is a private nonprofit organization helping to directly address gaps in health coverage and provide access to integrated medical, dental and behavioral health care for low-income, at-risk residents in Carroll County. We are centrally located in downtown Westminster in the Citizens Services Complex Building on Distillery Drive and provide health services full time, including chronic disease management, medication assistance, case management, and other critical wrap around services for whole-person health. In response to the opioid epidemic plaguing our community, we just expanded weekend hours to enable ambulatory detox and acute medical care services seven days a week.

Despite the greatest efforts of the Affordable Care Act, the fact remains that many thousands of residents are still without adequate access to health services, and <u>we need your help</u>. Access Carroll is positioned to be a leader and partner in achieving the best health outcomes for our community. As a premier health care home for low-income residents, Access Carroll is experiencing tremendous growth and demand for their services, and this year needs to raise approximately **\$1.4 Million Dollars** for operational expenses.

ACCESS CARROLL RESPONDING TO THE OPIOID CRISIS

The latest Carroll County Health Needs Assessment ranked mental health and illegal substance abuse in the top five health issues affecting our community. According to latest statistics from DHMH, there is a high prevalence of both mental health and substance use orders in Carroll County:

- * 1 in 5: Mental Health (approximately 33,000)
- * 1 in 10: Substance Use Disorder (approximately 17,000)

Over the recent months, both Maryland Governor Larry Hogan and President Donald Trump have acknowledged an opioid epidemic sweeping across our state and nation. Carroll County is also being heavily impacted with alarming numbers of overdoses, fatalities, and other devastating socioeconomic consequences due to opioid and chemical dependency. To further compound the issue is a lack of accessible resources to help those in need receive timely, supportive, and efficient care for recovery.

In a unique and strategic partnership with the Bureau of Prevention, Wellness, and Recovery of the Carroll County Health Department and Carroll Hospital, Access Carroll is directly combating the opioid epidemic through multiple highly collaborative efforts including:

- * Walk-In Substance Abuse Assessments
- * Ambulatory Detox Services for Opioids and Alcohol
- * Medication Assisted Treatment Maintenance Services
- * Individual, Group, and Family Counseling
- * Theracoustic Spas Sound Wave Therapy
- * Urgent Care for Crisis Intervention
- * HIV Testing
- * Naloxone (Narcan) Training for patients and community
- * Peer Recovery Support Services

Access Carroll is the only full time safety net in the community offering integrated health services including opioid and alcohol detoxification for Carroll County residents in need. And, as of November 2017, we are open on the weekends to enable these life-saving services 7 days a week. We need your help to ensure these services remain intact!





NO WRONG DOOR POLICY

Access Carroll has adopted the "no wrong door policy" — as have many other organizations in Carroll County! The goal of each staff member, both paid and volunteer, is to direct anyone walking in our doors with viable options for solutions, even when Access Carroll is not the needed solution. If we don't have the answer, we find someone who does and help connect those in need to the right place for the best answer. Access Carroll has a working relationship with many organizations in our community (in addition to our strategic partners-Carroll Hospital Center, Carroll County Health Department and the Partnership for a Healthier Carroll County), such as Anchor Pharmacy, Carroll County Youth Service Bureau, Carroll Transit System, Catastrophic Health Planners, Human Services Program of Carroll County, Shepherd's Staff and Westminster Rescue Mission — to name only a few. Organizations come together for training to reach

our community. In addition, we organize public events in our surrounding communities for education and awareness.

We work together to serve our Carroll County family, friends and neighbors in need.

HEALTHY MOUTH, HEALTHY BODY

Pegah Ghiasi, DDS has taken action to improve Carroll County's dental health as a leader in the integrated health care team, ensuring a patient's overall health and wellness from teeth to toes. To her patients, she is their champion for helping them discover the missing pieces to better health. Poor dental health has been linked to cardiovascular disease, respiratory infections and diabetic complications.

A Life Changing Smile For a Teenage Girl

This year, a 13 year old girl came in for a comprehensive dental exam with Dr. Ghiasi. Panoramic and bitewing x-rays revealed a diagnosis of Ectodermal Dysplasia of the teeth. People afflicted by this condition display with teeth missing altogether or reduced in number. Teeth that are present are widely spaced, tapered, or malformed. In persons with some types of Ectodermal Dysplasia, the enamel (outer layer of the teeth) is defective and there may be an excessive number of cavities.

When teeth are missing, the jawbones in which they are ordinarily embedded do not develop well, leading to a typical aged appearance in the face. Dr. Ghiasi devised a full treatment plan that included a combination of extractions, prosthetics, and restoration of teeth. Dr. Ghiasi arranged a consultation with specialists Dr. Michael Linnan & Dr. Arash Rostami, who provided complimentary assistance to the young patient and converted a partial denture into an over denture. As this young patient grows, she will require further orthodontics, prosthodontics and implants in the future, but Access Carroll will continue to be here to help her throughout her challenging journey with Ectodermal Dysplasia.


