Riding Policies

- Eating, drinking, smoking, chewing tobacco, "vaping", and using illegal or tobacco-like substances on Carroll Transit System vehicles is not permitted.
- Audio devices are not permitted unless using headsets and keeping the volume low so that others are not disturbed.
- For the safety of all passengers, please refrain from talking with the driver while the transit vehicle is in operation.
- Strollers are permitted only if folded before boarding.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Drivers may refuse to transport passengers that appear to be under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances or whose behavior appears abusive, offensive, or dangerous to others.

- O Route Deviation: additional \$1.00 (advance notice preferred)


Fares are paid upon boarding the vehicle. Exact change or a valid ticket or pass is required.
