Most of our patients have multiple chronic diseases like diabetes or high blood pressure. Most have urgent dental and oral health needs. Others are struggling with emotional illnesses like depression and substance use disorders.

Meeting patients where they are is important! Access Carroll provides intensive case management and individualized care coordination for complex patient needs ranging from access to food, shelter, and basic hygiene to specialty care appointments and life-saving procedures. Over the past year, Access Carroll provided 203 showers and assisted over 270 homeless individuals connect to community resources.

FISCAL YEAR 2023 PROJECTIONS & GOALS

Over the coming year, Access Carroll is estimating...

- 10,000 Individual men, women, & children will be seeking life-saving primary health care.
- 7,000 Primary Care visits will be provided to those most in need.
- 6,500 Behavioral Health Services, including intensive outpatient therapy.
- 3,500 Dental Care services, including hundreds of emergency extractions.
- 1,500 Substance Use Disorder Assessment and Treatment Services
- 6,500 Care Coordination and Intensive Case Management Services will be provided.
